Our top picks for some of the most picturesque wedding venues in the world, below.

Conradm, Maldives Rangali Island

Take one look at the homepage for the Conrad, and you'll probably go weak at the knees. Maybe it's the glistening blue water, the undersea restaurant, the white-sand beaches, or the marvelous fact that you can reserve the entire island for your wedding—either way, get to booking. This would be the trip of a lifetime.

Rosecliff at Newport Mansions, Newport, Rhode Island

Cue scenes from the *Great Gatsby*—especially because, ahem, this venue was featured in the movie (among other films). The epitome of New England Gilded Age charm, this beautiful 20th-century mansion is the stuff of dreams. Between the massive ballroom, the heart-shaped staircase, and a pristine front lawn that sweeps down to a grand fountain and then the crashing sea below, there is no doubt that Rosecliff Mansion offers unparalleled views and memories.

The Inn at Perry Cabin, Eastern Shore of Maryland

Your loved ones and you will have no trouble feeling right at home at the Inn at Perry Cabin on Maryland's picturesque Eastern Shore. Sprawling farmland meets the white-capped Chesapeake Bay, yielding a breathtaking setting for a late-summer or fall waterside wedding. The Inn accommodations are just as picture-perfect as the property's bright green golf course and clean crisp courts; you'll quickly find that there's no shortage of fun activities to plan during the celebratory weekend. Point 16, Big Sur, California

The sprawling, white, 6,500-square-foot barn has 30-foot arched ceilings and rustic exposed wooden beams, resulting in a delightfully elegant, countryside ceremony location. Couples can also choose to utilize the new Cliffside Barn, which is 1,000-square-feet of newly renovated, wooden-floored, high-ceilinged barn space with a covered deck overlooking the mountains. Southern charm starts right here.

The Plaza Hotelm, New York, New York

There's simply nothing like The Plaza. For city slickers in search of a venue that epitomizes sophistication, this legendary New York City hotel is as timeless as they come. Between the Grand Ballroom, the Terrace Room, Palm Court, and many others, options abound for couples to create a picture-perfect ceremony and reception at this iconic New York landmark.
